

Petition for Overload Academic Services

Fall/Spring overload policy: A student in good standing wishing to take 21 hours* or more, or a student on academic probation wishing to exceed 16 hours,* must petition the academic dean of his or her major for approval and have the support of the academic advisor.

Summer overload policy: A student with a minimum of 2.0 cumulative GPA wishing to take more than 10 hours* total in the summer term (the first and second sessions **combined**) must petition the academic dean of his or her major for approval and have the support of the academic advisor.

*Includes ALL courses to be taken at UE, abroad, and at other institutions.
