## **Financial Aid for Master of Public Service Administration 2010-2011**

PSA students who begin the program during the 2010-11 academic year (August 2010 or January 2011) may apply for the Federal Direct Stafford Loan. Students must file the 2010-11 Free Application for Federal Student aid (FAFSA) to begin the loan application process. Go to [www.fafsa.gov](http://www.fafsa.gov) to get started:

- Follow the link under Step 1 and **print a “FAFSA on the Web Worksheet”** – Completing the paper “FAFSA on the Web Worksheet” allows you to gather the correct answers before entering information live online.
- Locate or create your PIN (personal identification number) for use in filing the FAFSA electronically. Students may reuse PINs from a prior year or create a new PIN by following the link under Step 1.
- **Locate your 2009 federal tax return** – You will need this information to complete your 2010-11 FAFSA.
- When you have completed steps listed above, return to [www.fafsa.gov](http://www.fafsa.gov). Under Step 2, follow the link called “Fill Out Your FAFSA.”
- UE’s code for the FAFSA is **001795**.

**Tuition:** The tuition for the Master of Public Service Administration program for 2009-10 is \$7,470 (\$3,735 per semester). Costs for 2010-11 are not yet known. The maximum amount of Stafford Loan that could be certified in 2009-10 was \$19,650 (\$9,825 per semester). Borrowing the maximum amount will create a credit balance, giving you funds for books, supplies, living expenses, and other indirect costs.

**Loan Eligibility:** A portion of the Stafford Loan may qualify to be subsidized, where interest does not accrue during your enrollment period. Up to \$8,500 of the loan may be subsidized, while remaining amounts will be unsubsidized. Unsubsidized portions of the loan accrue interest during your enrollment period. The FAFSA determines the amount of subsidized eligibility. Repayment of the principal borrowed is deferred until six months after you graduate, withdraw, or drop below half-time enrollment. The Office of Financial Aid will notify you of your Federal Direct Stafford Loan eligibility after your acceptance in to the program and upon receipt of your FAFSA. Forms and further instructions will be provided at that time.
