Immunizations Policy

The University requires all full-time students to have a health card on file with the health center. Mandatory documentation includes two MMR (mumps, measles, rubella) vaccinations with dates, a tuberculosis skin test with results within the last six months and a tetanus shot within the last 10 years. Meningitis immunization is not required but is strongly recommended. Meningitis information is provided to incoming freshmen during the summer orientation program.
