APPLICATION INSTRUCTIONS

Application Deadline and Admission Deposit

We realize that often the decision to enroll may not be made until shortly before the semester actually begins. However, the earlier you apply and deposit, the better your chances are for campus housing, financial aid, scholarships, and class selection. Therefore, applications and admission deposits are accepted on a rolling basis.

Once you are admitted and decide to attend the University of Evansville, it is important that you submit your \$300 non-refundable deposit as soon as possible. This deposit reserves your place at the University and in campus housing. It also covers costs related to advising and registration. If you do not plan to live in campus housing, the balance of your deposit will be credited toward your tuition costs. Information about academic advising, class registration, and housing will be sent to you once your deposit is received. Housing is assigned on a space-available basis. Early application and deposit are strongly recommended.

Financial Aid and Scholarships for Transfer, Second Degree, and Re-entry Students

Financial aid and scholarships for transfer and re-entry students are determined on an individual basis. To be considered for federal, state, and University funding, you should submit the Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA) or the Renewal FAFSA. This form is available online at www.fafsa.gov. The University of Evansville's FAFSA code is **001795**.

If you wish to be considered for scholarships, refer to section F (page 6) of this application. Students who qualify for more than one University award will automatically receive only the one of the highest value. It is possible for scholarships to be reinstated for re-entry students depending upon how long the student has been away from the University of Evansville.

Students seeking a second baccalaureate degree, unless they are military veterans participating in the Yellow Ribbon Program, are ineligible for University scholarships and grants. However, loans may be available depending upon your situation. To be considered for loans, you should submit the FAFSA.

Transfer and Second Degree Applicants

Transfer applicants are those students who have graduated from high school or received a GED and thereafter earned college credit.

Second degree applicants are students who hold a baccalaureate degree but wish to complete an additional degree at the University of Evansville. Please complete the transfer and second degree applicant sections of the application.

Re-entry Applicants

Students who have been away from the University of Evansville for one semester or more are required to reapply for admission.

Re-entry applicants are those students who were formerly admitted to the University as degree-seeking students and have earned no more than nine credit hours elsewhere since leaving the University of Evansville. Formerly admitted students who have earned 10 credit hours or more are considered transfer students. Please refer to the transfer applicant sections of this application.

Re-entry students who hold baccalaureate degrees, but wish to complete additional degrees at Evansville, should complete the re-entry applicant sections of the application.

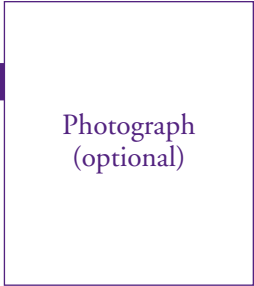

- Articulation Agreement Scholarship**
This award ranges from \$10,500 to \$13,000. Students must complete articulation agreement course work requirements and receive recommendations of endorsement from their academic advisors. - Fine and Performing Arts Scholarships**
Auditions or portfolio presentations are required when applying for scholarships in the Department of Art, Music, or Theatre. Talent is considered when awarding these scholarships. - Phi Theta Kappa Scholarship (honor society for community colleges and two-year institutions)**

- Ridgway Award \$18,000 per year**
Candidates for this \$18,000-per-year award must be dependent students who maintain permanent residence in Vanderburgh County or have graduated from an accredited high school located in Vanderburgh County. Students must agree to live in University housing while attending UE. Eligibility also requires a cumulative grade point average of at least 3.0 from previous institution(s).

Additional Scholarships:
