## APPLICATION TIMETABLE

### EARLY ACTION

- Admission decisions are mailed early, beginning in October 2011 and no later than December 15, 2011.
- Academic departments with special scholarships or selective programs may limit candidates to those who have applied by the early action date of December 1, 2011.
- While you have until May 1, 2012, to submit your \$300 reservation deposit, you are eligible to deposit early, qualifying you for priority housing, orientation, academic advising, and registration.

### REGULAR DECISION

*Complete your application by February 1, 2012*

- Admission decisions and University of Evansville scholarship and merit award notifications will be mailed no later than February 15, 2012.
- After February 1, applications are considered on a space-available basis. The University of Evansville reserves the right to close the application period after February 1, 2012.

### RESERVATION DEPOSIT

- Once you have been admitted to the University of Evansville, you may submit your \$300 nonrefundable reservation deposit.

## PHYSICAL THERAPY DIRECT ENTRY PROGRAM

- submit a completed Application for Admission and Scholarship (including the essay in section O) to the University of Evansville by November 1, 2011.

Candidates will be selected from those meeting the criteria above, and they will be invited to campus for an interview. Students selected for the direct entry program must meet specified criteria during the undergraduate period to enter the DPT program at the end of their junior or senior year.
