BEDROOM/SLEEPING

- □ Sheets (twin size X-long length)
- Comforter
- Blankets
- □ Pillow(s)/pillowcase(s)
- □ Mattress pad/cover
- Alarm clock
- □ Hangers

STUDYING/ELECTRONICS

- Textbooks (available at UE bookstore)
- Backpack or book-bag
- Binders and folders
- Notebooks
- □ Pens, pencils, and highlighters
- Calculator
- □ Scissors, stapler, and tape
- Index cards
- Personal calendar or planner
- □ Laptop or computer and chargers
- Headphones or earbuds
- Power strip with surge protector (UL approved)
- Grounded three-prong extension cords (UL approved)
- Ethernet cables for computer or gaming systems

TOILETRIES/PERSONAL HYGIENE PRODUCTS

- Towels and washcloths
- Shower caddy
- □ Shower shoes/flip flops
- Bathrobe
- $\hfill\square$ Shampoo, conditioner, soap etc.
- Deodorant
- $\hfill\square$ Toothbrush and toothpaste
- □ Hair dryer, curling irons, etc.
- Shaving items
- Eye care products
- Prescription and OTC medications
- □ Tissues

EATING

- □ Microwave (10 amps max.) dimensions not to exceed 11" h x 19" w x 15" d
- □ Compact refrigerator (2.5 amps max.)dimensions not to exceed 34" h x 20" w x 20" d
- □ Snacks and Drinks
- Dish soap and towels
- □ Coffee maker, electric tea kettle, toaster
- Plates, cups, dishes, and utensils
- □ Storage containers and Ziploc bags
- Paper towels

CLEANING

- Hand sanitizer
- Multipurpose cleaner
- □ HE laundry detergent and softener
- Lint brush
- □ Waste basket and plastic trash bags
- Air freshener
- Laundry bag or basket

EVERYTHING ELSE

- □ Room decorations
- Dry erase message board
- Throw rug
- □ Lamp (no halogen lights)
- 🔲 Digital TV
- Digital antenna for local stations
- Gaming systems
- Phone charger
- □ Flashlight and batteries
- □ Storage bins and crates
- □ Rain gear, umbrella, and rain boots
- Credit or Debit card
- Driver's license
- □ Insurance cards
- First aid kit
- Emergency supplies bag

Bring what you need to make yourself feel at home but remember that there is limited space in the room.

WHAT TO LEAVE BEHIND

- X Quarter Rolls Not necessary as our laundry services are free with your cost of housing!
- X Portable heaters or AC units
- X Hot plates/deep fryers/toaster ovens/open coil cooking appliances
- X Oil lamps/candles/candle warmers/wax warmers/incense
- X Pets (except fish in 10-gallon tank or smaller)
 Service animals and Emotional support animals must be registered before arrival though the Office of Disability Services.
- X Alcohol (prohibited except in 21+ approved housing)
- X Alcohol containers or alcohol decorations

- X Illegal drugs or drug paraphernalia
- X Tobacco Products: The campus is a tobacco-free environment. Tobacco use or the use of e-cigarettes will not be allowed in any University residence hall, Village properties, or Greek housing, as well as any adjacent grounds or parking areas.
- X Weapons or ammunition
- **X** Personal Loft Supplies: (Use only loft supplies provided by UE.
- X Nails, tacks or screws, double-stick tape (wall damage will result in charges at the end of the year). Poster putty is only acceptable in Moore, Hale, Powell, and Schroeder. We advise the limited use of Command Strip products - care must be taken when removing.

Once you find out your roommate's name and contact them, not only to introduce yourself, but also to decide who will bring what items.
