


Keynote Speaker

Dr. Lerone Martin

In 2022, Dr. Lerone Martin will become the newest faculty director for the Martin Luther King, Jr. Research and Education Institute at Stanford University. The King Institute supports a broad range of educational activities illuminating Dr. King's life and the movements he inspired. Martin will also serve as the Martin Luther King, Jr. Centennial Professor in the Department of Religious Studies.

Dr. Lerone Martin is the author of the award-winning *Preaching on Wax: The Phonograph and the Making of Modern African American Religion*, which tracks the role of the phonograph in the shaping of African American religion, culture, and politics during the first half of the twentieth century.
