



The full-time program consists of the following classes: (1) Listening and Speaking, (2) Reading, (3) Writing, (4) Grammar, and (5) Language Lab. Enrolling in fewer than all five of these classes is considered to be part-time attendance. Students on F-1 visas are required to enroll full-time. Enrolling in the TOEFL Preparation class does not count toward a full-time load.

Early arrival and/or late departure will result in additional housing fees. Students living on campus are required to purchase meal plans. Meal plan amount shown is the minimum; actual amount may be more depending on meal plan usage. During the <b>Summer Sessions</b> , room prices are different from those shown above and meal plans are not available, although students may eat in the dining center on a cash basis during times that service is offered.	

- Amounts shown above do not include costs of books, supplies, personal expenses, or possible costs of meeting the University's health requirements. Books cost approximately \$250 and need to be purchased once during the summer, once during the fall, and once during the spring.
- Registrations after the first day of classes are subject to a \$190 late registration fee.
- Refund requests are subject to the University's refund policy and any associated penalties. Cancellation of program will result in loss of Orientation/Placement Fee. Cancellation or early termination of housing agreement will result in loss of deposit and may incur additional penalty. Dropping classes on or after the first day of classes will affect amount of eligible refund.
