

Where Will You Live?

Do this first

Attend one of the posted information meetings for Villages (February 21) or Residence Halls (March 18)

Also

Submit your Housing and Food Service Contract via WebAdvisor starting March 1.

Now ask yourself

Where do you want to live next year?

I want an apartment, house, or townhouse.

I like my hall.

I want to change halls.

Different Hall

Great, here's what you need to do.

Get a group of students together who each have at least 44 completed credit hours by the end of Fall 2018 and apply for Village housing.

Request cards will be available from ResLife February 25 - March 1

Apply for two to five person Village units or single apartments.

Remember this

Village selection appointments will be e-mailed to students on March 4. Selection appointments will be held on March 6 - 8 at assigned times.

How do I pick my room?

Will you be a rising senior? (75+ completed hours by the end of Fall 2018)

Not yet

Will you be a rising junior? (44-74 completed hours by the end of Fall 2018)

Nope

Will you be a rising sophomore? (<43 completed hours by the end of Fall 2018)

Roommate follows his or her process for same hall and signs you up at his or her time.

Come to Eykamp Hall on March 19 starting at 9:00 p.m. to claim an open room in your same hall.

Come to Eykamp Hall on March 19 starting at 9:15 p.m. to claim an open room in your same hall.

Come to Eykamp Hall on March 19 starting at 9:30 p.m. to claim an open room in your same hall.

So follow this

Here's something else to think about.

Will you be living in a different hall with someone who currently lives in that hall?

We can help you find a roommate - just e-mail bc32 (singles cost 50 percent more).

Since you want a different hall...

Come to Eykamp Hall on March 20 to claim your room in a different residence hall than you currently live in. Specific selection times, based on earned credit hours, will be posted and emailed by March 20 to students who have submitted a Housing and Food Service Contract but not yet selected a room.

Note

Both you and your roommate can come at the same time.
