2021/2022 PAYMENT POLICY FOR RETURNING INTERNATIONAL STUDENTS

2021 Fall/2022 Spring Semester Payment Options

Full-time undergraduate and graduate international students may choose one of the following three options for satisfying their financial obligation to the University. Please choose one and note the due dates:

Option One: Pay the full fall amount due by August 15 and the full spring amount due by December 15.

Option Two: Pay the full semester amount due in two equal payments. With fall semester payments due on August 15 and September 15, and spring semester payments due on December 15 and January 15.

Option Three: Pay the first fall semester payment on August 15, with the second payment, plus a 1.5% finance charge due by September 15. The third and final fall payment, plus an additional 1.5% finance charge, due on or before October 15. The first spring semester payment will be due on December 15, with the second payment, plus a 1.5% finance charge, due by January 15. The third and final spring payment, plus an additional 1.5% finance charge, due on or before February 15.

METHODS OF PAYMENT

Students may bring U.S. funds in the form of a cashier's check drafted on a U.S. bank, traveler's check or via bank wire transfer. Cash is not accepted. Students are cautioned not to carry large sums of cash.

Bank wire information is printed on the estimated invoice provided in your packet. For additional wire information contact the Office of Student Accounts at offstudaccts@evansville.edu or call (812-488-2565).

IMPORTANT: Be sure to indicate student's name and the student's University of Evansville identification number on all wire transfers. A wire fee of \$16 should be included with each wire sent.

CAUTION: The University of Evansville will never request a wire be sent to an individual. All wires should be sent directly to the University of Evansville with the student listed as beneficiary.

Credit Card Payment

The University of Evansville accepts **MasterCard, VISA, American Express, and Discover** credit cards for payments of tuition and fees. Payments made by credit card will be subject to a 2.5% service fee.

Note: Please check with the issuing bank to make sure that the credit card can be used in the United States and to determine daily transaction limits.

Any student unable to satisfy the University of Evansville payment requirements will be subject to dismissal from the University, which may result in loss of visa status by the United States Citizenship and Immigration Services (USCIS).
