

TRANSFERRING TO THE UNIVERSITY OF EVANSVILLE

Many students who start at Ivy Tech Community College are successful transfer students to the University of Evansville. Work with your Ivy Tech academic advisor and take these steps to create your transfer pathway to UE.



STEP 1: Explore UE

It's important to research the University of Evansville while you're attending Ivy Tech to determine if UE is right for you.

STEP 2: Come See Us

Tour campus and meet with a transfer admission counselor, professors in your area of interest, and a career advisor. The University also hosts Purple Visit Day group visits throughout the year. Schedule a visit that works best for you online at evansville.edu/visit or by calling **1-833-BeAnAce (1-833-232-6223)**. UE offers a \$1,000 per year award simply for visiting campus!



STEP 3: Apply for Admission, Scholarships, and Financial Aid

Apply for admission to UE at evansville.edu/TransferApply.

For optimal consideration for admission and scholarships, apply by the following dates:

- Fall semester - August 1
- Spring semester - December 1

Applications will continue to be evaluated after these dates as time permits.

***Academic scholarships for admitted Nursing majors, regardless of GPA, is replaced with UE's National Need for Nursing Scholarship worth \$25,000 per year.*

Transfer Engagement Awards | Transfer Students Entering Fall 2024/Spring 2025*

Receive additional scholarships simply by filing the FAFSA, visiting our campus.

Engagement Activity	Scholarship Amount (renewable annually)	How to Qualify
File the FAFSA	\$1,000	File the FAFSA at fafsa.gov and enter UE's school code: 001795 (not applicable for international students). FAFSA results must be received by June 15, 2024, for Fall 2024 applicants and November 15, 2024, for Spring 2025 applicants.
In-Person Visit	\$1,000	Visit our campus and participate in an individual, in-person guided campus tour and admission counselor session or an in-person group visit day. Must visit campus by June 15, 2024, for Fall 2024 and November 15, 2024, for Spring 2025 applicants.

* Students entering UE for the first time in the 2024-25 academic year may qualify for these engagement awards.

Special Scholarships

Special scholarships may replace or add to Transfer Academic Scholarships.

- **Ivy Tech/UE Guaranteed Admission Scholarship:** Students earning an associate degree from Ivy Tech (after June 2020) are guaranteed a minimum scholarship of \$20,000 per year at UE. Those who also qualify for a Transfer Academic Scholarship will be awarded the scholarship of the highest amount.
- **Ivy Tech ASAP Scholarship:** \$2,000 per year (add-on).
- **Phi Theta Kappa Scholarship:** \$2,000 per year (add-on).
- **Legacy Award:** \$2,000 per year for children and grandchildren of UE graduates (add-on).
- **Methodist Scholarship:** \$500 per year (add-on).
- **Yellow Ribbon Award* (for qualifying veterans and their dependents):** Students may receive up to full tuition (UE scholarships and financial aid awards vary in association with military education benefits).

Discounted Tuition Rates

- **Elementary and Secondary Education Majors reduced tuition rate*:** Students at Ivy Tech who are majoring in Education and have earned an associate degree or a minimum of 55 credit hours will qualify for a special tuition rate per credit hour.

*Students receiving special tuition rates or full tuition benefits are not eligible for UE scholarships.

STEP 4: Submit Your Admission Deposit and Register for Classes

Once you have made your decision to attend UE, submit your nonrefundable \$150 admission deposit. An academic advisor will provide an official review of your transfer credits and register you for classes. UE is generous with transfer credits, so you can expect most of your Ivy Tech credits will transfer. UE hosts an orientation program for transfer students before each semester designed to ease the transition and welcome new students to campus.
