- RESPECT all campers, staff, campus equipment and facilities, and yourself
 - Vandalism (clogging drains, toilets, fountains, etc.)
 - Use appropriate language (no cursing, swearing, etc.)
 - Do not slam doors, stand on furniture, write on university property, etc.

- FOLLOW DIRECTIONS

- Cell phones are permitted but cannot be used to take photos or video of campers or staff
 - Campers should not be texting or having phone conversations during camp activities
 - If phone usage is interrupting camp activities and/or camper's ability to participate, camp leader will request the phone and it will be returned at the end of the activity
 - If phone usage continues to be an issue, parent and/or guardian will be notified and phone will be surrendered to parent and/or guardian at the end of the day
 - Please let your camp leader know if you need to make a call or respond to messages
 - Phones should be silenced prior to camp arrival
 - Campers are responsible for keeping up with phones
 - UE is not responsible for lost or damaged phones
 - Do not loan or allow other campers to use your phone
